



## British Chevening Scholarships

## INFORMATION FOR REFEREES

The scholarship scheme of the United Kingdom Foreign & Commonwealth Office

The British Chevening Scholarships programme for China is one of the most prestigious schemes available from the British Government that enables Chinese nationals to receive further educational training in Britain.

Scholarships will be offered for a period of not more than one year, normally commencing in September/ October.

## Competition for places is intense and candidates must meet a number of criteria:

- Potential for managerial or policy-making responsibility Chevening graduates must be capable of 'real
  achievement' in a senior role in sectors of government, industry, commerce, finance, law, education,
  science and technology and culture.
- Motivation The programme is demanding both mentally and physically. Chevening scholars must either successfully complete a Masters course in not more than 12 months or complete all objectives of the pro posed research.
- Experience Desirable 5 years plus, Essential minimum 3 years.
- Qualifications Students normally have a good first degree and/or professional qualifications.
   We accept a small number of exceptional students without prior formal qualifications.

Our selection procedure to assess candidates' attributes is complex and comprehensive. It involves two references: one academic and one business based, a formal individual interview with a British Embassy desk officer and a whole morning of written and verbal tests, as well as a detailed scrutiny of the applicant's career and achievements.
